For academically inclined students with a grade point average (GPA) of a B or better, and are excelling in the field of the English Language Arts course.

The CTCEC will review and approve the applications. In the event that there is a tie for application received for a certain grade, the CTCEC will decide on who the final recipient will be based on the highest GPA, attendance, citizenship, and community involvement.
