MATH/SCIENCE BURSARY

GUIDELINES FOR APPLICATION:

Cowichan Tribes Cultural & Education Committee is offering cash for both Math and Science courses. These awards are available to Cowichan Tribes student in grades 8 – 12. This is a cash award, and a maximum of five awards will be made every year for each grade.

Award Categories:

1. A Grade 8 student is eligible to receive \$100.00
2. A Grade 9 student is eligible to receive \$150.00
3. A Grade 10 student is eligible to receive \$200.00
4. A Grade 11 student is eligible to receive \$250.00
5. A Grade 12 student is eligible to receive \$300.00

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

For academically inclined students with a grade point average (GPA) of a “B” or better, and who are academically excelling in the field of both math and science.

RULES OF THE COMMITTEE:

The Cowichan Tribes Cultural & Education Committee (CTCEC) will review and approve the applications. In the event that there is a tie for applications received for a certain grade level; the CTCEC will decide who will be the final recipient based on the highest grade point average, attendance, citizenship, and community involvement.
